We decided to take control of rising health care costs and found a win-win option for employees and employers," said Tammy Flora, Vice President of Human Resources for Masters Gallery Foods. "A majority of health issues are lifestyle related, so our philosophy with the Center is to effect positive behavioral change. Long-term, behavioral changes can trigger improvement in future generations as well, critical when you consider that children are projected to have shorter life spans than their parents," said David Bolland, President and CEO of Plymouth Foam.

When asked about the key to the Center's success, Jeff Giffin, President and CEO of Masters Gallery Foods, stated, "If you make quality health care available every day in a professional environment, led by people who truly have your best interest at heart, successful outcomes are going to occur."
