Additionally, Masters Gallery Foods finalized an onsite nitrogen generation system in 2022, increasing energy efficiency, reducing transportation needs, and improving worker safety in the food packaging process.

The company began developing a comprehensive greenhouse gas emissions inventory to better drive sustainability forward. Tracking emissions on a regular basis will help guide future sustainability initiatives and find opportunities to reduce the company's carbon footprint further.
